Short-term roles - Expression of Interest

ICC World Cricket League 2 series - Forfarshire CC

We have a number of exciting short-term opportunities available during July 2024, when Forfarshire CC host 6 one-day internationals (ODI) during the ICC World Cricket League 2 series.

Expressions of interest are now sought from individuals within the cricket community with the relevant skills/experience interested in undertaking several short-term roles to support the Cricket Scotland Operations team.

Roles available:

- Match Manager
- Team Liaison Officer x 2

Further information in relation to each role, including time commitment, is provided below, along with the relevant application link.

Outline of Roles Available

Match Manager

The Match Manager will work with the ICC Match Referee and will fulfil all the roles ordinarily assigned to a Match Referee, excluding the investigation or adjudication of alleged breaches of the Code of Conduct, which is managed by the ICC Match Referee.

The Match Manager will:

- Be responsible for the compiling of a comprehensive list of match contact details.
- Remain in contact with the ICC Referee throughout the course of the schedule of matches, and, thereafter, for a period of 48 hours following the completion of the final game.

- Become fully familiar with the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel and in particular those sections pertaining to the disciplinary process.
- Facilitate a pre-match/series meeting, which, ideally, should take place the evening before the first day of scheduled play and be attended by the ICC Match Referee, Team Captains, Team Managers and Match Umpires.

Hours of Work:

7 days – practice day held on June 1, followed by six ODI fixtures on 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12 June.

Pay: £120 per day

Team Liaison Officer x 2

The Team Liaison Officer is the main contact for a team and will manage all day-to-day issues relating to all aspects of the team and ensure the general interest and welfare of players.

The Team Liaison Officer will:

- Report directly to the Cricket Scotland (CS) Tournament Manager and liaise closely with the Venue Manager, Match Manager and CS staff as appropriate.
- Assist the Team Manager with accommodation. travel. team activities and functional arrangements.
- Assist with laundry operations within the hotel.
- Liaise with Match Officials (prior to, and on match day).
- Assist with training, media. VIP hospitality, official functions. bat signings, team event presentations.
- Be the principal point of contact for team management. the ICC and the event operations team to communicate all day-to-day issues.

There will two Team Liaison Officer roles allocated to the Netherlands and Nepal respectively.

Hours of Work:

12 days between 1 June to 12 June.

Pay: £100 per day plus mileage and lunch on match days.

Place of Work

The tournament is being played at Forthill Community Sports Club, Broughty Ferry, Dundee. Please note successful candidates will be required to work in the UK and have a Visa that allows the candidate to undertake this form of employment in the UK.
