CRICKET PNG NATIONAL TEAMS HEAD COACHES



Cricket PNG is seeking interested candidates for four full-time National Head Coach positions to be based in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea.

- 1) Barramundis (Senior Men's) Head Coach
- 2) Lewas (Senior Women's) Head Coach
- 3) Garamuts (Under 19 Men's) Head Coach
- 4) Siales (Under 19 Women's) Head Coach

Each position will oversee and lead the ongoing development of one of Cricket PNG's four national cricket teams. The overarching objective for all four teams is to qualify for ICC World Cups. The Lewas need to elevate both their ICC ODI and T20I global rankings, and the Barramundis need to regain ODI status as well as elevate their T20I global ranking.

All positions will link closely with Cricket PNG's National Academy and Talent Identification programs, and with other staff within the Cricket PNG High Performance Department. You will be expected to work closely with regional and national players and coaches, increasing the depth and readiness of our emerging talent to ensure longer-term success and to meet the objectives stated above.

These positions are consistent with Pillar 1 (International Success) of Cricket PNG's 2025-2032 Strategic Plan. All activities must be delivered within the parameters set by the Cricket PNG annual operational plan and budget. The direct reporting line of Senior Head Coaches is to the Cricket PNG High Performance Manager (or CEO as applicable). The U19 Head Coaches will report to their respective Senior Head Coach.

Interested candidates should send both a **cover letter** (max. 2 pages) and **CV** (max. 3 pages) to recruitment@cricketpng.org clearly indicating the position or positions of interest and explaining why they are a strong candidate for that specific position. All positions are open to both citizens and non-citizens of PNG. Women are highly encouraged to apply.

The cover letter and CV should be received by **Sunday 13 July 2025**. Short-listed candidates will be sent a full job description to consider prior to any interview, which we intend to commence in mid July.
