Wednesday the 11th of June – Sunday the 15th of June.

*A reserve day has been allocated for Monday the 16th of June, if required.

Who are the two teams playing in the final?

South Africa v Australia.

Where can I purchase tickets for the World Test Championship Final?

Tickets can be purchased online at tickets.worldtestchampionship.com.

What categories of tickets and pricing are available in the public stands?

Tickets are available in the following categories and pricing:

Please note all wheelchair and ambulant-disabled tickets are priced at Category D, regardless of location. We are pleased to provide one complimentary carer ticket for those that require a carer to accompany them on a match day. PIP or DLA documentation may be requested.

When will Day 5 tickets go on sale?

Tickets for Day 5 are currently not on sale but will become available to purchase via <u>tickets.worldtestchampionship.com</u> within a month of the match. Please refer to the above website for up-to-date information about Day 5 tickets and pricing.

When will Day 6 tickets go on sale?

As Day 6 is a reserve day, tickets will only be made available to purchase on a first-come, first-served basis, via **tickets.worldtestchampionship.com** once it has been confirmed that Day 6 is required. Please keep an eye on email communications regarding these tickets once the match is underway.

Are there any group discounts available for this game?

For group bookings of 12+ tickets, in one transaction, a 10% discount shall be applicable.

In which stands are tickets available for the World Test Championship Final?

Tickets are available in the following public stands for the World Test Championship Final:

- Grand Stand Lower
- Compton Stand Lower
- Compton Stand Upper
- Edrich Stand Lower
- Edrich Stand Upper
- Mound Stand Lower

Please note, the Upper Grand Stand is a designated debenture area; however, any tickets returned to us will be made available to purchase at a later date.

Will my seat be under cover or in the open?

How many tickets can I purchase?

You may purchase up to 20 tickets per day in a single transaction.

What credit and debit cards do you accept for payment?

We accept all major debit and credit cards, including American Express.

Do you offer no-alcohol seating areas?

Yes. Our no-alcohol block can be found in Block 1 of the Compton Stand Lower.

What can I bring to Lord's with me for the ICC World Test Championship Final 2025?

Small quantities of alcohol may be brought into Lord's, but is limited to the equivalent of:

- 1. one bottle of wine or Champagne (max. 750ml), or
- 2. two cans/bottles of beer/cider (max. 500ml each), or
- 3. two cans of premixed aperitifs (max. 330ml each) per adult spectator.

Small flags and banners are permitted within the stadium for this fixture. Please check our Ground Regulations <u>lords.org/information/general-ground-regulations</u> for specifications on permitted sizes and further information relating to what can and cannot be brought into the ground.

What are the rules around under-16 and unaccompanied children?

To qualify for an Under 16 ticket, you need to be under 16 at the time of the match. If you are 16 or older you need an adult ticket.

Any Under-16 ticket holders who are 14 years or younger must be accompanied by an adult ticket holder.

If you are only looking to purchase Under-16 tickets, this cannot be completed online, and you will need to contact Club Services on **0207 432 1000**.

I'm bringing an infant; do they require a ticket?

Any babes-in-arms may be carried into the ground free of charge, so long as they will not occupy a seat themselves. A ticket is required for any child aged three years or older on the day of the match.

How will I receive my tickets?

Public stand tickets will be available via the ICC App. You can download the ICC App for free for Apple users via the **Apple App Store** and for Android users via the **Google Play Store**.

Please keep a record of the email address and password used to purchase the tickets at tickets.worldtestchampionship.com, as you will require these to log in to the ICC App to view your tickets.

When will I receive my tickets?

Digital tickets will be available in the ICC App four weeks prior to the ICC World Test Championship Final 2025.

How and when will I access my tickets?

Digital tickets will be available via the ICC App. The ICC App is free to download for Apple users via the **Apple App Store** and for Android users via the **Google Play Store**.

Tickets will be available a month before the final, with additional details to follow. Please ensure you make a note of the email and password details you used to purchase the tickets as you will require these to download the tickets from the ICC App closer to match day.

Further details and 'how to' guide will be shared with ticket holders in May.



Is there a transaction fee?

Yes, a £2.50 transaction fee is applied to each purchase, in the overall basket cost. This is a pass-through cost associated with the digital ticketing requirement for the event via the ICC App.

Can I get a printed ticket?

All public stand tickets are digital and self-service, no tickets can be printed, emailed or posted to you.

In exceptional circumstances, self-service print at home PDF tickets will be made available to access two weeks prior to the match day.

What is the refund policy for the World Test Championship Final?

No refunds will be given, other than those covered under the appropriate refund schemes.

If I cannot attend, can I give my tickets to family/friends?

Yes, you are able to share your tickets with your friends and family. Please note we strongly discourage the use of third-party resale sites and the sale of tickets at greater than face value is strictly against the T&Cs of ticket use.

Please see below for further information regarding our resale platform, which is activated for sold-out match days only, to allow ticket holders to return their tickets back to the Club for resale.

Can I sell my tickets on a third-party website?

Cricket is against ticket touting – you must not buy or sell this ticket for more than its face value. All tickets are issued by MCC. Each Ticket is and shall remain at all times the property of MCC and the original ticket purchaser must acknowledge the T&Cs of sale before completing their transaction. Can I change the age category of a ticket?

Yes, you can change the age category of a ticket by contacting Club Services on 0207 432 1000.

Will there be a resale platform in operation?

We are pleased to provide a ticket resale facility for our sold-out match days, providing those who are no longer able to attend with a secure platform to obtain a refund on tickets resold to those who were note previously able to buy tickets for the match day.

Please note that you will not receive a refund unless and until your tickets are re-purchased. The original card details used for the purchase will be refunded.
