After these time periods we will anonymise your personal data and keep it for analysis of engagement trends.

After these periods, we will take steps to delete your personal data or hold it in a form that no longer identifies you if we have no further lawful basis requiring us to maintain your data. Where we maintain a record of cricket matches, we will retain your data indefinitely.

Your rights. You have the right to opt-out of direct marketing, the right to withdraw any consent at any time (if you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which consent was held prior to your withdrawing it), the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, you can require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it and the right of data portability.
